### ***ROE 12 Provides Statewide Leadership in Helping Schools Implement New Federal Bus Driver Training Mandate***

ROE 12 is proud to have provided leadership for not only our local school districts, but for school districts statewide with the development and rollout of the Theory Component of the federally-mandated Entry Level Drivers' Training (ELDT) in Illinois. Assistant Regional Superintendent Corrie Ray and ROE 12 Student Transportation Consultant Penny York, working collaboratively with our local school district transportation directors, reviewed the law's requirements and authored a curriculum which meets the components of the MAP-21 legislation. Over eighty participants from ROEs and school districts across the state participated (many virtually) in an overview session last week at Lincoln Trail College. This collaboration is just another example of how ROEs work to solve problems, save local schools money, and ensure student safety!
