Learning Olympiad Returns After Hiatus for COVID

Regional Superintendent of Schools Monte Newlin recently announced the results of their annual Learning Olympiad. The Olympiad is a friendly, structured competition providing an academic atmosphere filled with creative thinking and problem solving exercises. With an array of hands-on activities, questions, and challenges across the curriculum of Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, and the Arts, school teams of 4 students each compete against other schools' teams. Each school may enter up to two teams. This year's event for high school students was held on November 9th. Central Christian Church in Lawrenceville again served as the venue for the event. 188 students in grades three through twelve participated.
