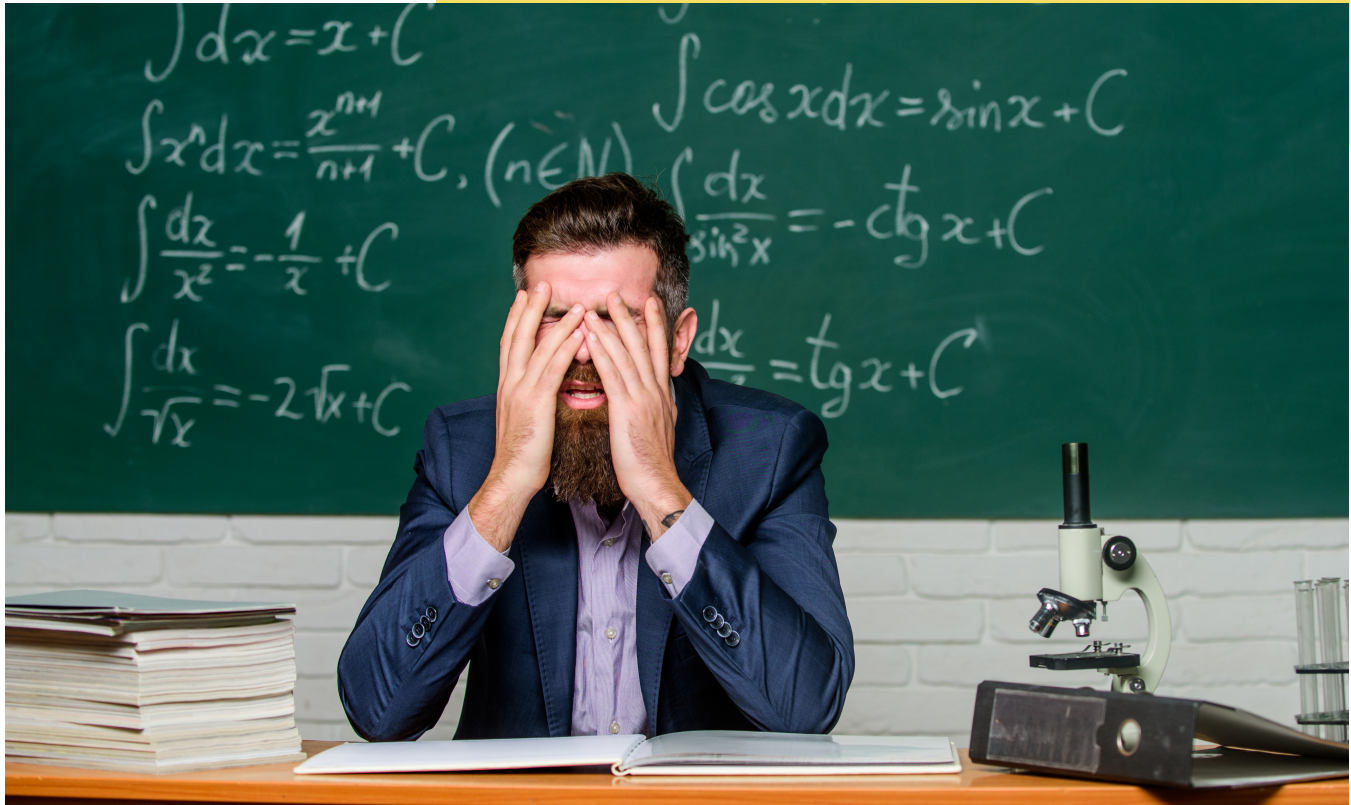




COMPASSION FATIGUE AND BURNOUT: Is your staff at risk?
